Our Gift of Hope Sonogram Center and Sprinter vehicle continues to help pregnant women CHOOSE LIFE for their innocent preborn babies. **Since 2015 our center has saved over 1,373 babies.** Here are a few of our recent “saved” babies.

Eva came to Our Gift of Hope with her friend who had told Eva about our services. **Her friend had been helped by OGOH and had “saved” her baby after getting a sonogram.** Scared and not sure what to do, Eva speaks very little English and has 3 children at home under

7 years old. She has not told her husband about her pregnancy. Eva spoke with our sonogram technician who gave her an ultrasound and discovered she was 21 weeks pregnant and having a baby girl. Eva said she knew she was pregnant but had no idea that she was that far along. **Eva cried as she looked at the picture of her baby on the sonogram machine and saw how big her baby was and said that if we can help her she will call her husband and tell him that she is pregnant.** Eva was very grateful for all the information about WIC and the other government programs where they can get help since her husband is not working at this time. **Eva gave birth to her daughter on 12/17/18 a few weeks earlier than expected.**

Ritzi is 21 years old, speaks little English and has a 5 year old daughter. **Our Gift of Hope manager asked Ritzi why she wanted to terminate her pregnancy and she said that she is young and would like to finish school since she dropped out five years ago to take care of her first child.** Rosie told Ritzi that she can go to night school or a community college to get her GED. Rosie offered Ritzi a sonogram and it showed that she was going to have a baby boy in January 2019. **Ritzi was happy to see the baby on the screen and her daughter had been telling her**

mother that she was going to have a little boy and she was correct!!! Ritzi lives at home and was very concerned that her mother was going to be so upset with her and would want her to get an abortion. **Ritzi feels things are going to be a little rough around her home but after seeing her baby and hearing her baby’s heart beating so strong she CHOSE LIFE for her baby.**

In 2012, a desperate pregnant woman named Prim from Uganda reached out to Several Sources, through the internet, asking for help with her pregnancy. After being counseled by me through our numerous emails and many uplifting prayers, **Prim gave birth to a beautiful baby girl.** Since that time Prim has been helping other pregnant women CHOOSE LIFE for their innocent preborn with our occasional assistance. **Prim has honored us by naming her organization, Gift of Hope - Uganda.** Here are just a few stories:

Anita at 18 years of age became pregnant for the first time. **She was 3 months pregnant when she decided that she needed to terminate her pregnancy.** Anita was a student at a school where the city was constructing a new road. She met and fell in love with one of the engineers on the construction site who was from Germany and was only in Uganda until the road project was completed. Anita thought she would be taken to Germany since the baby's dad lived there but she was wrong. **He left Uganda without her.** She became so miserable because she could not reach the baby's dad. **Her family threw her out of the house and called her all sorts of names.** Since she had no place to live she went to a nearby church to help her with food and shelter. **Gift of Hope – Uganda was immediately contacted and Prim was able to provide Anita with shelter and take care of her basic needs.** Anita's son Alex was born on 10-4-17.

Sarah (20 years old) is a good student but unfortunately got pregnant with a college student named Tom. **At 2 months pregnant she went to hospital for an abortion.** Being that in Uganda it is illegal to abort, she was not able to do so. One of the health personnel who knows about Gift of Hope - Uganda wrote to Prim about the situation. She counseled Sarah and talked to her about the dangers of abortion. She then watched with her the movie “The Silent Scream” and immediately she let go of the thought of abortion. **Thanks be to God her parents are Christian, and Prim talked to them using the “letters to mom and dad” from our Several Sources hotline kit and they began to support their daughter.** Sarah gave birth to her daughter Angela on July 4, 2017.

God bless you and thank you for your compassion and generosity to God's innocent preborn children on this Mother's Day and throughout the entire year.
